

I. History of WLAC DH Program

- 1972: One of the first community college programs to offer Dental Hygiene Program in California
- 1976: State pilot project on local anesthesia, soft tissue curettage and nitrous oxide/oxygen sedation.
- 2002: First Registered Dental Hygienist in Alternative Practice program approved in the state of California Access to Healthcare Bill.

- 4 programs currently offer bachelor degrees in California

- 2 Bachelor completion programs in California
