
AMONG THE LOWEST TUITION IN THE U.S.A.

THE FIRST STEP TOWARD A BACHELOR'S DEGREE OR CAREER PREPARATION

At West, students may complete the first two years of course work required for a bachelor's degree -- but at a much lower cost than they would pay at a private college or university. The student may then transfer to a 4-year university as a junior (3rd year college student).

West also offers 2-year associate degree programs in high paying occupations such as dental hygiene, nursing, computer science, business, aircraft mechanics, computer science, child development, and more.









The Right Option For You

West has an active international student population from over 50 different countries who study and explore together, but are also well integrated into the greater college community of American students. In addition to the college's International Club, you will find our international students in the Associated Student Government, honors organizations, the International Student Success Program, and other student clubs.
