

CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING (CPL) – INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION

Grades for CPL Earned with Industry Certification

Per AP 4235, grading basis for credit for prior learning using industry certification shall be only Pass/No Pass (P/NP). Students who wish to earn a letter grade should pursue the credit by exam option for each specific eligible course.

Student Eligibility:

- 1. Have active student status (Student ID Number) at West Los Angeles College for the current term (must have current application on file). Must be eligible to enroll
- 2. Provide required documentation for each course applying for CPL (i.e., previous certification, current license, passed industry exam, official transcripts, etc.)

Instructions:

- 1. Apply to West Los Angeles College for current or upcoming semester (www.WLAC.edu)
- 2. Verify that the course(s) is/are eligible for CPL via industry certification proof
- 3. Complete and submit CPL petition, along with required evidence to CPL-petition@wlac.edu
 Students MUST enter the same full name that they registered under and matches our Student Information System (SIS).
