Osher Initiative for California Community College Students Scholarship Application

Thanks to the generosity of The Bernard Osher Foundation, thousands of California Community College students, like you, may receive an Osher Scholarship as part of the California Community Colleges Scholarship Endowment. Mr. Osher's vision is to "not only benefit the community college students of today but countless more for years to come."

Criteria

- Students attending FALL 2020 semester must have completed 24 or more "degree applicable" semester units (or the equivalent) at West Los Angeles College at the time of the initial scholarship disbursement.
- Students must be enrolled at least half-time (6 or more units) at West Los Angeles College during all terms in which the award remains active.
- Students must have received a California Community College Board of Governor's Fee Waiver.

Amount of award:

Awards will be adjusted based on enrolled status at West each semester and will be determined as follows:

- Full-time (12 or more units per term) = up to \$600/semester
- Three-quarter-time (9 - 11.99 units per term) = up to \$450/semester
- Half-time (6 - 8.99 units per term) = up to \$300/semester
