



HOW TO APPLY TO WEST LA COLLEGE FALL 2017 (For New CCCAPPLY Users)

STEP 1

Begin by visiting international.wlac.edu and click on the link highlighted above

Why WEST? West Los Angeles College (West) is a fully accredited 2-year California Community College where students can complete an Associate degree, the first half of a Bachelor's degree, or a career skills Certificate for significantly less than they would pay at a university or private career college. What is an Associate Degree? The Associate degree typically takes two years to complete. An Associate degree will qualify a student to enter many satisfying careers. Or it can be the 1ST STEP IN EARNING A BACHELOR'S DEGREE. After completing the Associate degree, students can advance ("transfer") to any major university as a 3rd-year student ("junior"). At the university, the student completes the last half of the Bachelor's degree requirements. Note: Completing the first half of a Bachelor's degree at a community college is a significant savings in tuition. [LEARN MORE](#)

STEP 3

Scroll down and click the blue "BEGIN APPLICATION" bar. Take note of the 4 items (in blue box) above to identify the supplemental application materials you will be required to submit.

Make sure to be accurate and provide complete details when submitting your application.

To be considered for admissions the following documents are required:

1. West Los Angeles College International Student Application
2. Evidence of English Language Proficiency
3. Evidence of Financial Support
4. Application Processing Fee

Applicants that wish to obtain a FORM I-20 to attend WLAC Part-Time must submit the online application by **June 30, 2017**. All supporting documents must be received by July 15, 2017.

Part-Time concurrent applicants (i.e. will enroll in one class at WLAC and are full-time at another college for Fall 2017) must submit the application by **August 18, 2017**.

STEP 4

Select "Create an Account". This will take you to the OpenCCC Apply application center.



STEP 5

Select “Begin Creating My Account” if you have never submitted an OpenCCC Apply application




STEP 6

The top part of the next page requires you to provide basic information (i.e. name, date of birth, etc.). We highly recommend you enter your name as it appears in your passport and/or visa. If you do not have a passport or visa, enter your name as it appears on your birth certificate


In the **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** section, make sure to click the following:

“I plan to apply for admission to college or financial aid” AND “Check this box if you do not have a Social Security Number”



STEP 7


The yellow “pop up” window will appear. Do not be concerned. Make sure to press “” to continue with your application.



STEP 8

Continue by providing your contact information. After providing your telephone number, make sure to click “My permanent address is outside the United States”.

This is required for all international students (even if you are currently studying inside the U.S.)



STEP 9

You will need to create a unique username and passcode. Your online account will be safeguarded when you enter a Security Pin and select security question and answers.

We highly recommend you email yourself with the account log in information.
