Majors approved for F1 students are determined each academic year. Majors that do not conform to F1 Visa enrollment requirements are omitted from this form; but may be approved again when the scheduling and format of the classes align with F1 Visa student enrollment standards.

University Transfer Path

West will admit students for any major that is related to a university transfer goal. We encourage you to meet with an academic counselor at West immediately following the completion of West’s assessment test (when applicable) to confirm that West offers the appropriate courses for your major.

Transfer Degrees: Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Science (A.S.)

A degree designed to provide a clear pathway to a CSU major and baccalaureate degree consisting of a minimum of 60 degree-applicable semester units. Students awarded this degree are guaranteed admission with junior standing in the CSU system and given priority consideration to their local CSU campus or to a program that is deemed similar to their community college major.
