^A The amount reflects minimum, full-time enrollment. F1 visa students are required to enroll/complete 12 units per fall/spring semesters.

⁴ Students are advised to consult with their academic counselor after receiving admission to determine if enrollment in winter/summer intercessions is beneficial. Typically, an increase of units per semester and enrollment in winter/summer accelerates completion of educational goal. Increased unit per semester and winter/summer enrollment increases student tuition accordingly.

⁵ Additional needs education and living expense needs for 9-month period (not including summer). Per individual cost varies based on living accommodations and lifestyle choices.

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Proof of Funds Requirements

Any prospective international student seeking to obtain a “Form I-20 – Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status” must submit an (a) application, (b) evidence of English proficiency and, (c) qualifying proof of funds. Review the information below to identify the minimum proof of funds and criteria used to evaluate financial documents.
