ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

West will approve any of the following English proficiency indicators for admissions purposes by West's International Students Programs.

- *Attendance at U.S. high school for a min. of two years**
- *Attendance at a U.S. college or university with a passing grade in English 101 or equivalent**
- *International Baccalaureate with an English Language score of 3 or better*
- *TOEFL min. score of 450 PBT or 45 IBT; WLAC (TOEFL Code is 4964)*
- *IELTS minimum score of 5.0*
- *iTEP minimum score of 3.0*
- *STEP-Eiken min. score for 2nd grade of at least 75% and Results Pass*
- *Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) score of "C" or better*
- *Cambridge General Certificate of Education reflecting A Level Placement*

****Transcripts from a prior high school, college or university must be submitted along with a prerequisite petition to West's Admissions & Records for official review before considered for admissions purposes by the International Student Program.***
