



# Wildcats

Wildcat Football had an exciting season defeating local rival SMC and making it to the league championship which they lost to East LA College. Despite the loss, West finished number 6 in the State with stats including first in passing yards per game (376.2), third in first downs per game (26.5), third in yards per game (517.1), and sixth in points per game (41.3).

**INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENTS** Individually, quarterback Jorge Reyna (top left) finished first nationally in six passing categories: passing yards, passing yards per game, pass completions, completion percentage, passing touchdowns, and total touchdowns. He was named Southern California Football Association (SCFA) – American Metro League – Offensive Player of the Year in recognition of throwing for more yards per game than any quarterback in the CCCAA at 364.4 yards per game. During the season, he threw for 3,646 yards on 70.6 percent completions while tossing 39 touchdowns to only 8 interceptions. He was signed by Fresno State University with a full scholarship.

Wide receivers Daniel Bell and Rasheed Cox led the nation in receptions with 94 and 73 respectively.

**ALUMNI IN THE NEWS** Football alumni highlights include Tray Boone who was featured on ESPN's SportsCenter play of the day clips for his front flip over a Dakota State defender to score a touchdown for Dickinson State. Will Lacey, Jr., now at Lane College, was selected to compete in the HBCU Spirit of America Bowl and Derek Stewart was named starting quarterback for the Bearcats at St. Vincent University.

West's 2016 Athlete of the Year Doshawn Franks, has transferred to NCAA Div. I Northern Illinois University with a track scholarship. Her main events will be the 400 and 800 meters.

West goalie Monica Stieber signed on with the soccer team at St. Francis University in Fort Wayne, IN. She will begin at St. Francis, on scholarship, in Spring 2017.
