

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

As a result of the Science and Math Construction efforts, it is necessary to have planned interruptions to campus telecommunications, data, fire alarm and low voltage devices such as the campus' master clock system. This is necessary due to the fact that the existing underground conduits and manholes are located in the area of the new building's footprint.

The first of three interruptions are planned to reroute existing wires and cables into new underground conduits and manholes. The construction team is planning to interrupt services for fire alarm and the campus master clock system this Friday, April 25, 2008. This will affect the northerly portions of the campus including the B and CE buildings. The interruption will begin as soon as 7:00 a.m. and continue no later than 10:00 p.m. In the event the work is not completed due to unforeseen circumstances, the construction crew will resume work on the next day until complete.

During the time the Fire Alarm is out of service under the oversight of the Division of State Architect, the Inspector of Record, will oversee a fire watch in which trained personnel will monitor the campus to report incidents of fire or smoke to the Fire Department in lieu of the campus fire alarm.

In the next few days, this effort will be finalized by meeting with campus staff and the construction team to make this change over of underground cabling as transparent as possible.

The next two consecutive Fridays and/or Saturdays (May 2 and 9) are planned to complete the change over of cabling for telecommunications and computer data networks. As the details of these projects are finalized, you will receive additional notification.
