<p>Friday 10/17 10am – 12pm</p>	<p>Introduction to Online Teaching and Learning This workshop is designed for those looking for an introduction to the rapidly growing world of online education. The fundamentals of online teaching and learning will be addressed, including the technical tools and teaching skills needed to succeed.</p>
<p>Friday 10/17 1pm – 2pm</p>	<p>Introduction to Podcasting for Education This introductory workshop is designed for faculty interested in learning more about Podcasting in education. This is the first step towards creating and distributing your own Podcasts here at WLAC!</p>
<p>Friday 10/24 10am – 12pm</p>	<p>Introduction to Hybrid Courses This workshop is for those interested in developing courses that include both online and face-to-face components – the best of both worlds! All Weekend College courses fall into this category.</p>
<p>Friday 10/24 1pm – 3pm</p>	<p>Blogging for Education (and Recreation) This hands-on workshop introduces you to the exiting world of blogging. This session will cover what a blog is and is not, why blogs are so popular and valuable, and how you set up your own professional-looking blog for free!</p>
<p>Wednesday 10/29 1pm – 3pm</p>	<p>TurnItIn.com and Other Strategies to Prevent Cheating and Plagiarism In this workshop, proactive strategies to discourage student cheating and plagiarism will be addressed. By rethinking traditional approaches to evaluation and incorporating the use of anti-plagiarism software like TurnItIn.com, this significant concern can be remedied. TurnItIn.com is free for use by WLAC online and Weekend College instructors.</p>
<p>Wednesday 11/19 10am – 12pm</p>	<p>Introduction to ETUDES Online Course Management System This workshop introduces you to the ETUDES Course Management System used by WLAC for online course delivery. This orientation positions you to successfully complete the ETUDES Instructor Certification course (EDUC 210) required to teach online or Weekend College courses.</p>
<p>Wednesday 11/19 1pm – 3pm</p>	<p>Introduction to Web 2.0 Technologies “Web 2.0” is the term used to describe new uses of the World Wide Web which enhance creativity, information sharing, and collaboration. This workshop will introduce you to the most popular Web 2.0 technologies, including Podcasting, ePortfolios, Blogs, Wikis, and Social Networking sites.</p>
<p>Wednesdays 12/3 and 12/10 3pm – 5pm</p> <p>Online participation required between class sessions</p>	<p>Online Pedagogy – How to Teach Online (Weeklong Intensive) Designed for current and aspiring online and hybrid instructors. This week-long intensive course addresses online teaching best practices. This is more than technology training – it’s an introduction to the theories and strategies that lead to successful online instruction. This course is an ideal compliment to the ETUDES Instructor Certification course (EDUC 210) required to teach online or Weekend College courses. Delivered in a hybrid format, this weeklong course requires two face-to-face meetings in conjunction with online work. By the end you will produce a pedagogically-informed lesson plan for use in your real or hypothetical online or hybrid course.</p>
