## FAQs

You've come this far at West. Now finish strong at California State University, Dominguez Hills...

...Inside our classrooms and across campus, you'll find a diverse community of learners. We welcome your experiences and contributions. What's more, we support your success in the classroom and beyond.

The South Bay's only public university, CSUDH has a strong partnership with West. Together they support your success and offer opportunities for career, education, and professional growth.

*Pathways Academy* offers support services to transfer from West to CSUDH in Biochemistry, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Computer Technology, Earth Science, Geology, Mathematics, or Physics. West students need at least a 2.75 GPA and have taken (or be eligible to take) English 101 and Math 125 (or their equivalent).

### Do I have to major in one of the listed majors mentioned in order to participate in *Pathways*?

Yes. Current enrollment in the *Pathways* program is for students who are interested in one of the listed majors.

### How long is the *Pathways* program?

It varies for each student. The *Pathways* Program Coordinator will help each student to develop an individualized academic plan that serves as a road-map for graduating from CSUDH with a Bachelor's degree. In general, students will attend West for 2 years to complete General Education requirements for an A.A. degree and 2 additional years at CSUDH to complete major requirements for a B.A. degree.

### How do I know if I qualify?

To find out if you qualify, please call or email the Program Coordinator at West. Information for contacting the office and staff is listed on the back.

### What do I need to provide in my application?

A completed application consists of 1) filling out the form 2) providing an unofficial copy of your West transcript and 3) responding to 3 short-answer questions.

### How do I know if CSUDH is the right university for me?

Choosing the right university is key to student success. To find out if you can see yourself at CSUDH, contact the *Pathways* Program Coordinator to set up a meeting, attend a *Pathways* Information Session to talk to campus representatives, or take a class at CSUDH for only \$10/semester.
