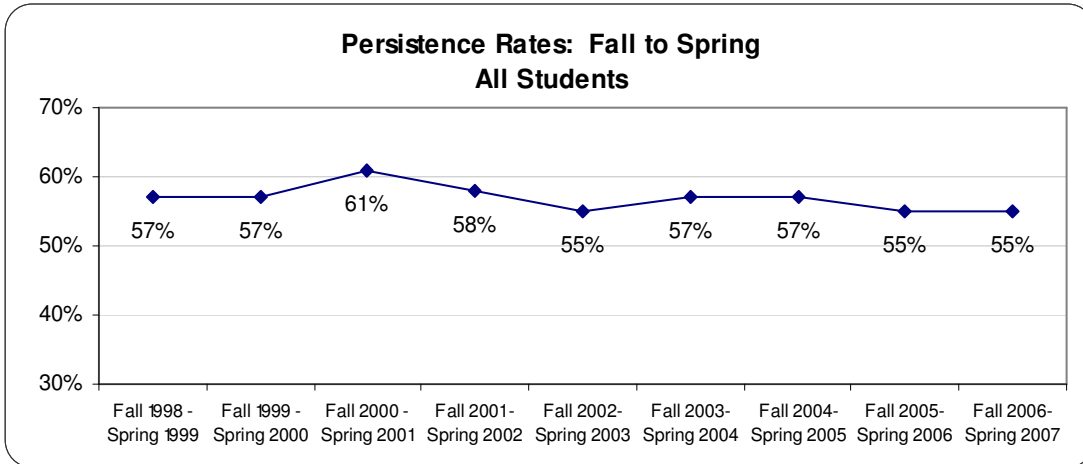

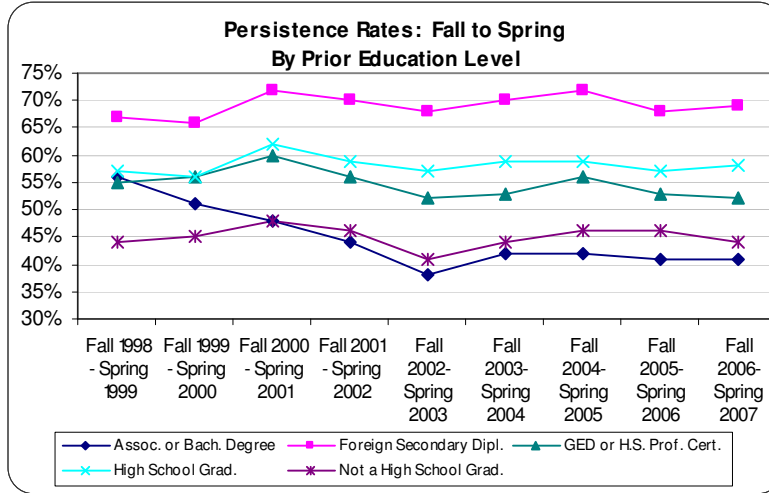

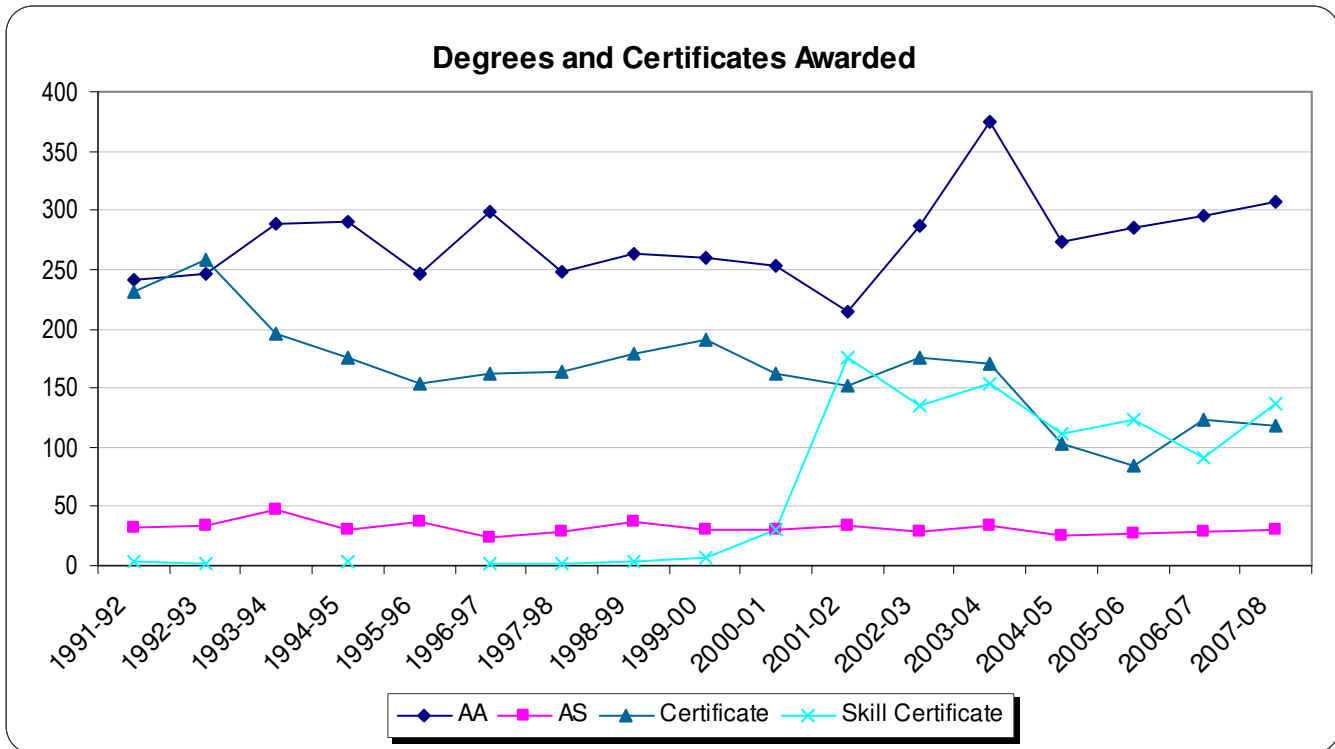

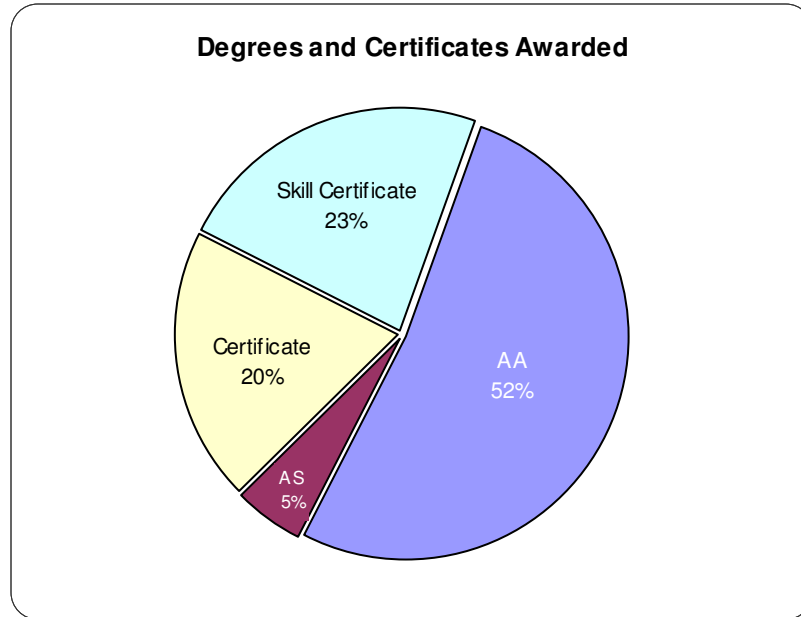

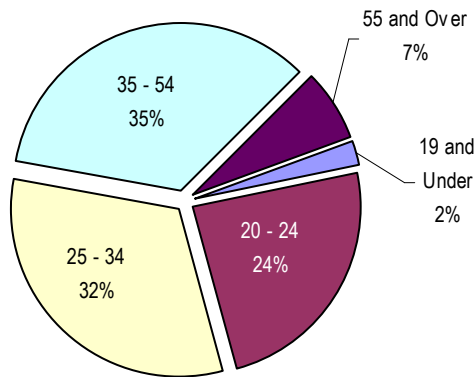
Awards by Gender



Awards by Ethnicity

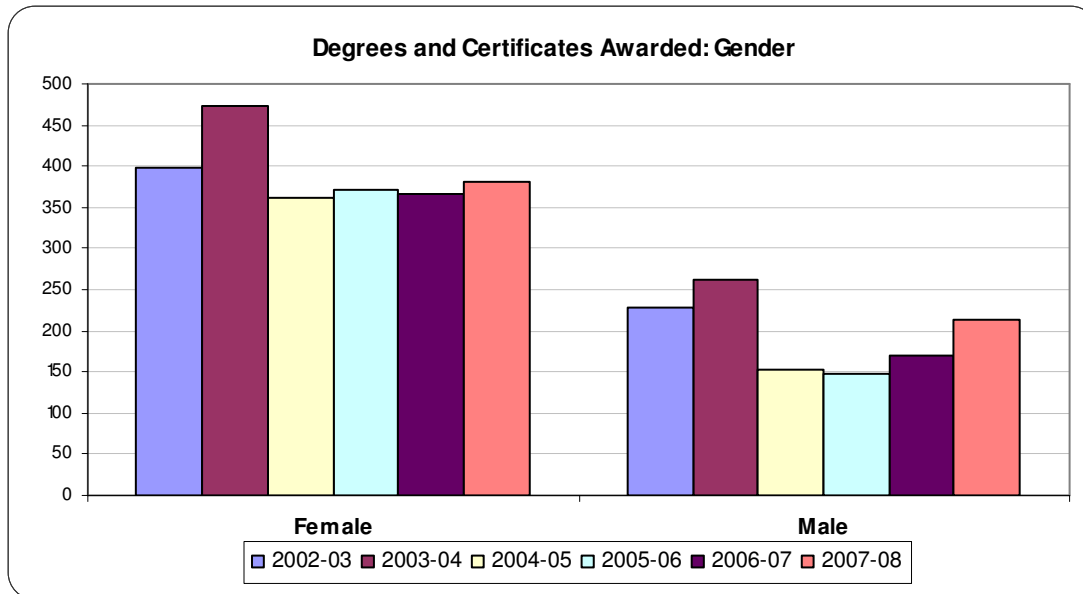


Awards by Age Group

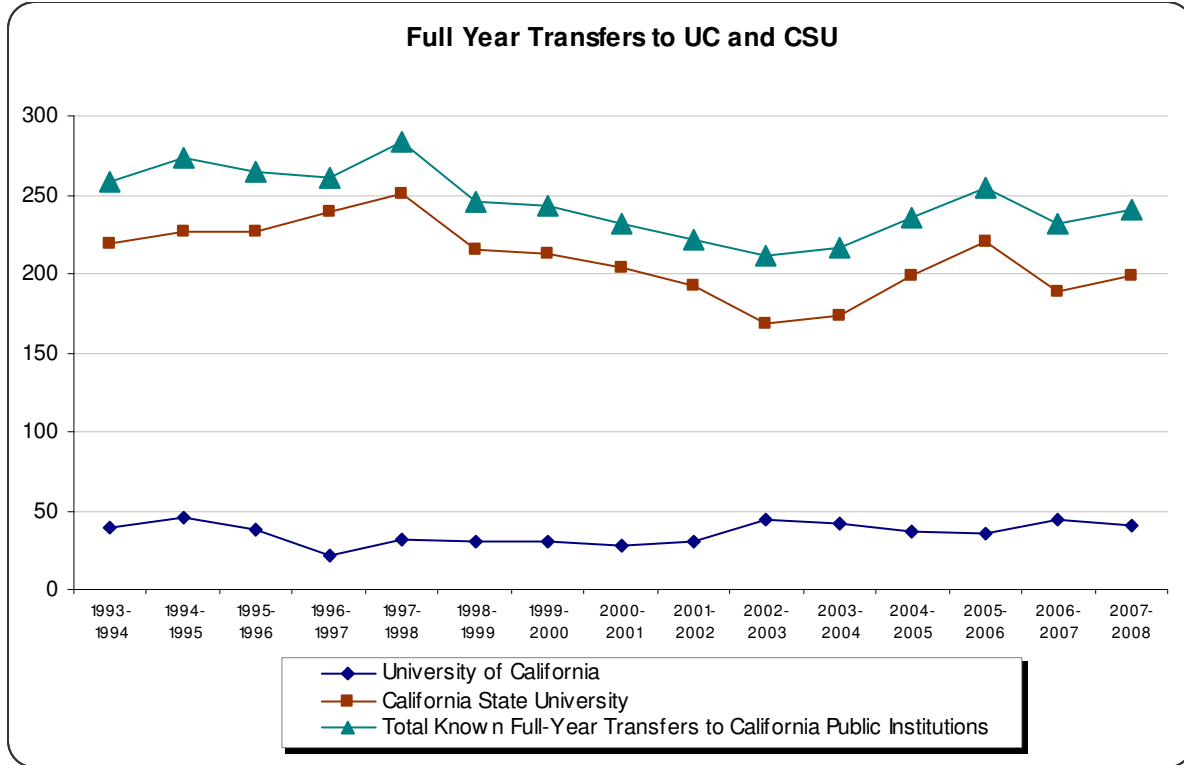

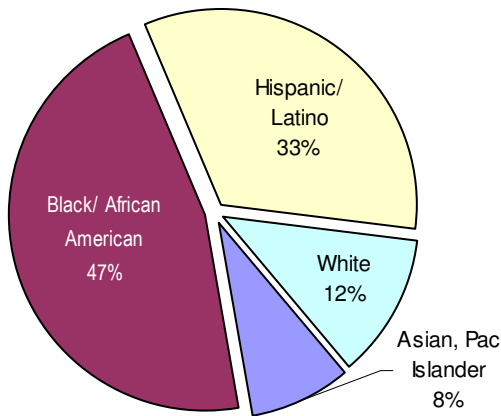

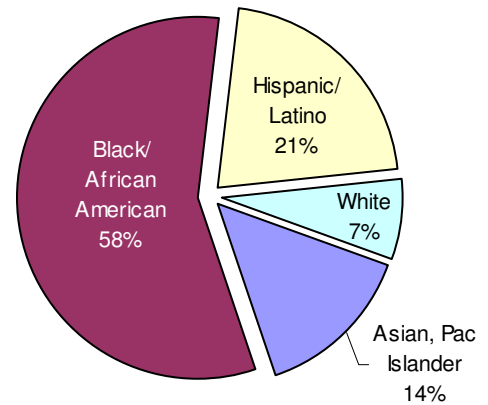

Ethnic Distribution of Transfers to University of California, California State University, and Private Colleges Fall 2007

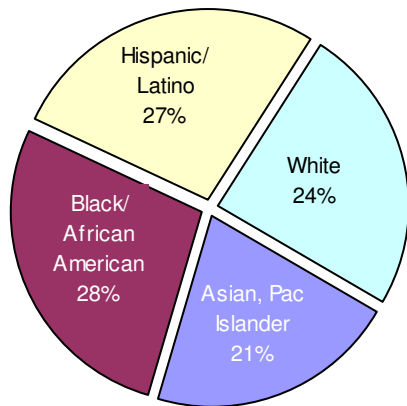
Combined Transfers to UC, CSU, and Private



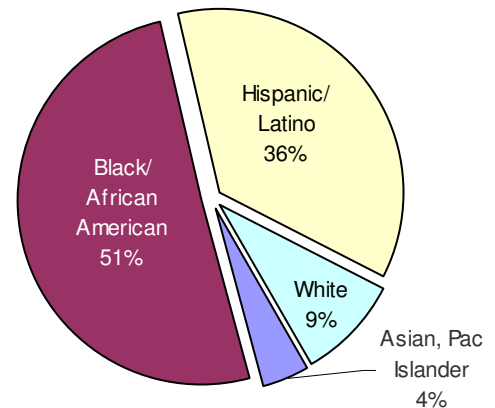

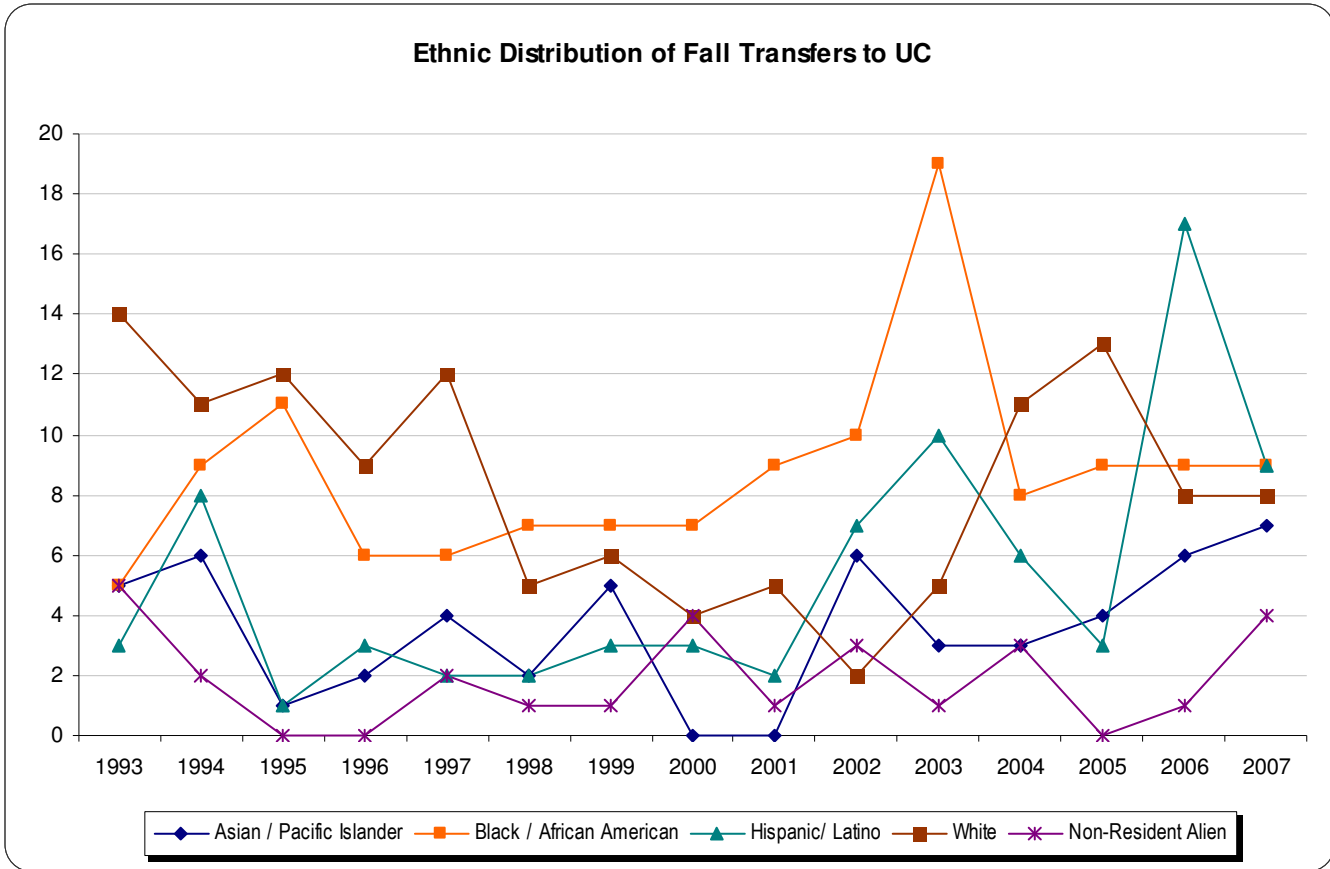

Ethnic Distribution of Fall Transfers to the University of California Fall 1993—Fall 2007

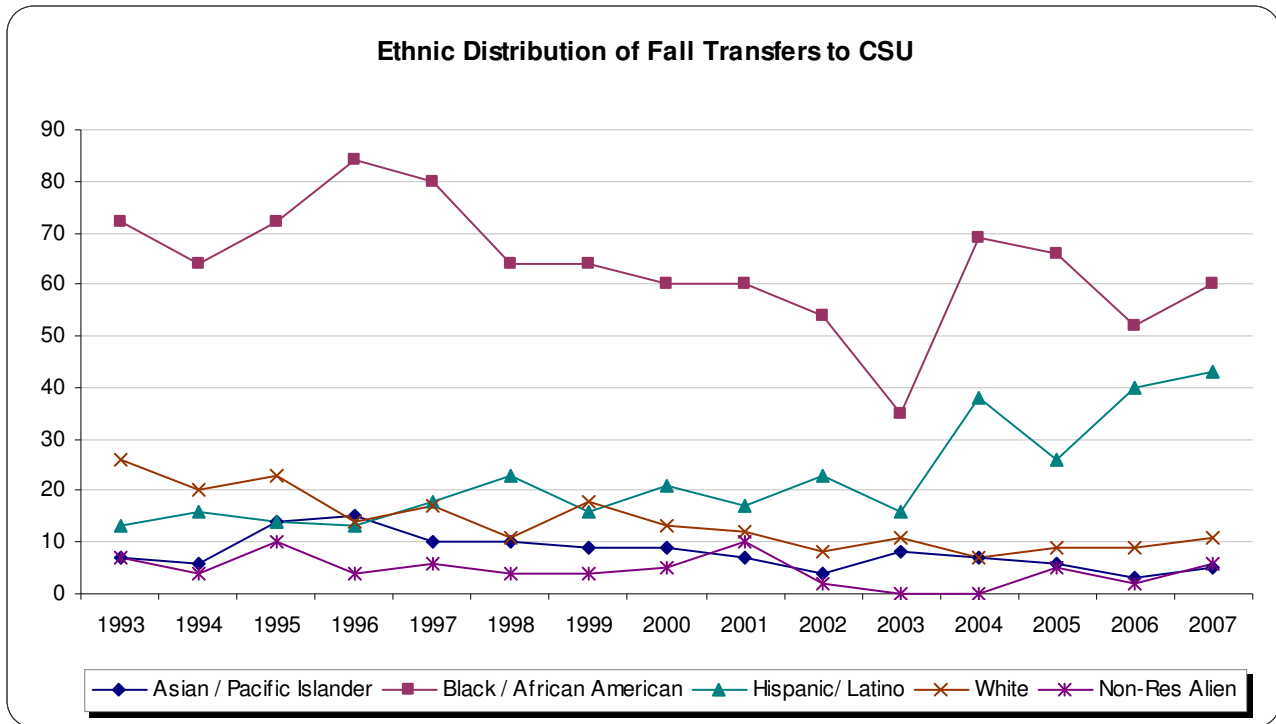

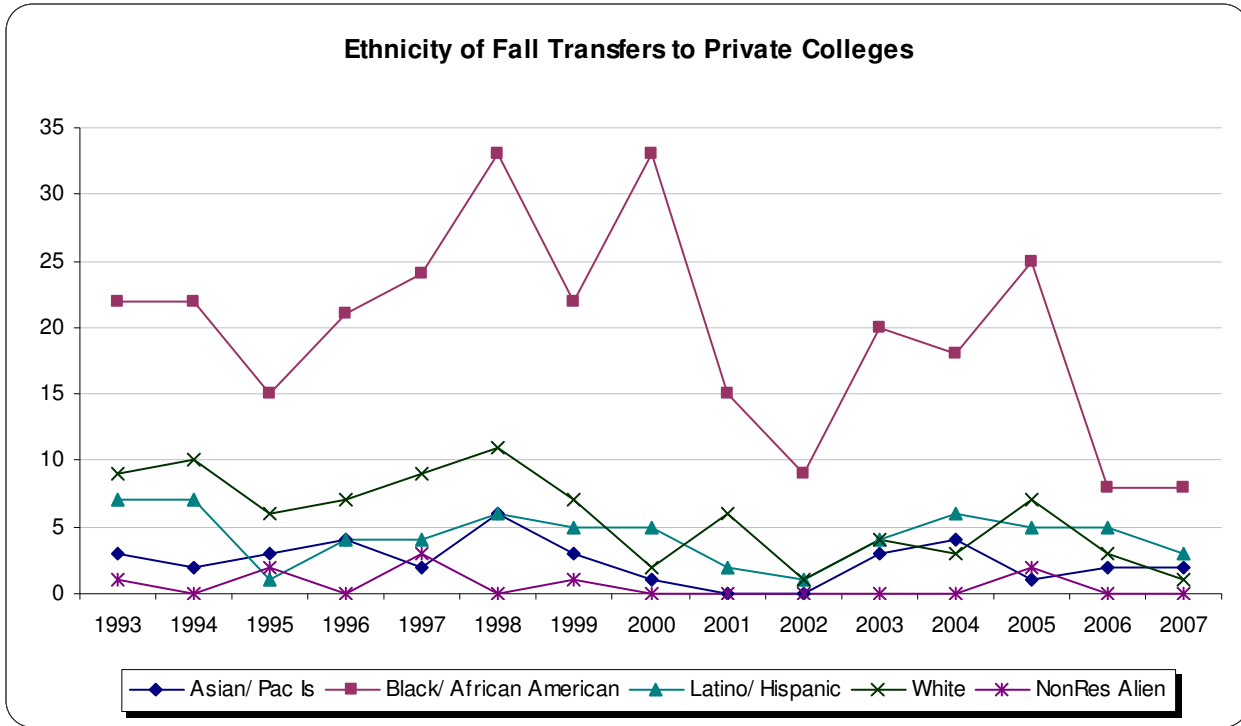
Ethnic Distribution of Fall Transfers to the California State Colleges and Universities Fall 1993—Fall 2007
