Student Representation Fee ~ \$1 per semester

This required fee benefits WLAC students by enabling your ASO to respond to legislative issues which impact students directly, i.e. tuition increases, textbooks taxes, community college funding. The ASO advocates and lobbies on your behalf at the District or in Sacramento and coordinates their efforts with the state and regional community college student organization (California Student Senate). The ASO is your legally designated liaison with the college, the District Office, the California State Chancellor's Office and the Board of Governors. They represent the WLAC student before local, state and federal government organizations. You can waive your right to be represented by completing a form available in the Business Office, A-13, or in ASO, Building A-5.
