



Invitation to Apply

SLO Leaders – 8 positions

Academic Affairs seeks approximately 8 West faculty members to participate in an SLO expert training on January 7, 2013, from 10 am – 2 pm. Lunch will be served, and a stipend (\$1,000) will be provided for training and committing to serve as an ongoing resource to other faculty in one-on-one and small group meetings. \$400 will be provided upon completion of the training, and \$600 will be provided upon: (1) submission of an implementation plan of faculty consultations, (2) completion of meetings with faculty, and (3) submission of products such as SLO assessment reports.

SLO Coach – 1 position

Academic Affairs seeks 1 West faculty member to lead 3-4 interactive workshops on the SLO cycle, focusing on faculty discussion of assessment results, changes based on assessment, and integration with planning, between January 21 and February 1, 2013. A stipend of \$900 will be provided. Additional workshops throughout the spring 2013 semester may be scheduled. (Refreshments will be provided at the workshops.)

Application Process

Interested applicants must be West Los Angeles College faculty. Applicants should submit a letter of interest that identifies the position(s) they have chosen:

1. SLO Leader (approx. 8 positions)
2. SLO Coach (1 position)

Letters must be submitted to Ms. Fierro in the Office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs by Thursday, December 20, no later than 4 pm. Letters can be about one page, should state your reasons for or interest in applying, and should include relevant qualifications and experience with the SLO cycle: development, assessment, dialogue, and implementation of changes. Selected applicants will be invited to meet on Thursday, January 3 in the afternoon to discuss the position and their interest in it. Those selected will be notified by January 4, 2013.
