-Makeup

Students must come to class prepared, with a professional-quality makeup kit. Makeup must be hygienic so it can be used on others (in order for liquid/cream products to be hygienic, they must be unopened). All items should be stocked in a variety of colors to work on a variety of skin tones. Recommended items are foundations, concealers, powders, blushes, eye shadows and pencils, lip sticks and pencils, brow pencils, and mascara. You'll also need a foundation brush, blush and powder brushes, a rounded eye shadow brush and a flat eye shadow brush, a liner brush and an angled brush. And, of course: sponge applicators, wipes, q-tips, tissues, sharpeners, brush cleaner and a mixing palette and knife.
