- 2. Submit the completed petition and any support documentation to the department chairperson. (i.e., English Department Chair or Mathematics Department Chair). Department contact information listed on the reverse side.
- 3. The receiving department will evaluate the student's request and will notify the student and Counseling accordingly. Only Department Chairs or Designees may submit approved Challenge Petitions to Counseling.
- 4. No units will be granted for successfully challenged courses by this request. To challenge a course for credit, refer to the process for earning credit by examination in the college catalog.
